


HOW TO MAKE FILM PRODUCTION MORE ECO-FRIENDLY

The film industry was valued at \$50.40 billion in 2021 and is predicted to be worth \$91.73 billion by 2030, but how much will this astronomical growth cost the environment? HOW DOES FILM PRODUCTION AFFECT THE ENVIRONMENT?

Film production sets are fascinating places, but they aren't exactly known for being eco-friendly and are often the culprit behind substantial environmental consequences such as:

DAMAGE TO THE LOCAL AREA

It is easy to forget that movies are filmed in real places. Large numbers of cast and crew members descend upon an area for sometimes months on end, erecting huge backdrops and installing impressive props. Once they're finished, there is often a trail of destruction left behind, including rubbish, pollution, trampled trees, muddy ground, and even damage to protected habitats.


